Greetings Dear Covenant Partner,

I pray this letter finds you living in the Lord's richest blessings.

I want to share in this month's teaching letter, "Finding Your Purpose When Life Happens". This is a little part of a teaching that I did in a service at our US Headquarters in Caddo Mills, Texas.

Before you go any further, grab your Bible and read the 4 chapters in the book of Ruth. Now think about what you just read. We all should know that God is good BUT life happens, and it happens to all of us. Just because you're born again and living for God, does not mean you become exempt from life. Now before you go saying, "Satan this and Satan that", realize Satan is fully defeated - past, present and future! Jesus took care of defeating him at the cross, but daily, Satan will use temptation to derail you. But again, LIFE HAPPENS! Sickness, disease, death, calamity, lack and such are real BUT by faith we can overcome IF we will not give up. I know that many might be thinking, "Well I prayed, but they still died" or "I prayed and still lost my job". Whatever you just thought about doesn't change the fact, you **are** victorious according to 1 Cor 15:57. Victory might not look like what you pictured it to be. However, you become fully victorious when you have the faith to put it into God's hands and trust that this too shall pass. Kingdom victory by faith is not when things look better, but when you pray and believe God at His Word.

Getting back to Ruth - when I read about the life of Ruth, I see a roller coaster ride, but in the end, God restored and multiplied her and Naomi. I know that the world and religious minds will try explaining this away, but God is God and He will never change. He loves you just as He did Ruth and all the others that walked out their journeys and into their season of restoration. Never try and put your victory on a time line.

I made a note in my journal program a few days ago that went like this, "Throughout history, one of the greatest battlefields where more battles have been lost, rest right between our ears". Much of the time, we talk ourselves out of our victory before God ever has a chance to move. We must walk by faith and not by sight (2 Cor 5:7). Now I don't say that as though it's always easy; BUT, victory can require longer battles at times. We need to daily enter battle knowing that Jesus secured the victory for us. Even in DEATH, WE WIN! GLORY TO GOD!!!! Even in a time of loss, WE WIN! Again, victory is not always going to feel or look like what we pictured BUT nothing changes the Word of God that declares **this day** you're victorious in Christ!

Ruth committed herself to Naomi just as we need to commit ourselves to God and through His Word we find truth, revelation and the strength to overcome and walk out this journey we call life.
